#### INTRAMURAL UPDATE

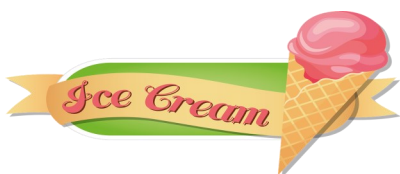
The Grade 6-8's are currently playing Handball. The Grade 3-5's finished Floor Hockey and will be starting Broomball in the gym as their next sport.

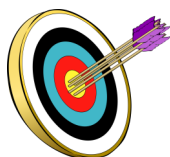
